

CRUISE GUIDE

Congratulations on earning the Unicity Americas Rewards Trip! We are excited to have you join us on board the Enchantment of the Sea for a relaxing get away to the incredible Caribbean Sea and the Bahamas. So, sit back, relax and let's get started!



PRE-TRIP INFORMATION- These are the things you need to prepare and know to make your trip more enjoyable.

DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS

Port of Miami- Dodge Island
1015 N. America Way

From Miami International Airport (7 Miles):

- Take I-95 south to Exit 38 (NW 8th Street).
- Turn left at the end of the exit ramp onto 5th street. Continue on 5th street and drive across the port bridge.
- You can also enter the port via I-395/SR-887/MacArthur Causeway to the Port of Miami Tunnel. Once in the port you will see signs welcoming you to the Port of Miami, follow directional to the designated ships terminal.
- Follow the signs to your ship's location.

From Fort Lauderdale International (26 Miles):

- Take I-95 south to Exit 30 (NW 8th Street).
- Turn Left at the end of the exit ramp onto 5th Street.
- Continue on 5th Street and Drive cross the port bridge.
- You can also enter the port via I-395/SR-887/MacArthur Causeway to the Port of Miami Tunnel. Once in the port you will see signs welcoming you to the Port of Miami, follow directional to the designated ships terminal.
- Follow the signs to your ship's location.

WHAT TO PACK

Our voyage will be a very relaxing cruise and mostly casual. There is one formal night (ladies in dresses, men in slacks and button up shirts, shoes that attach are also required so no flip-flops) that you may want to attend. For the most part, think sun, sun and more sun! Plan on shorts and casual dress for the duration of the trip. Remember to bring sunscreen!

The average temperature in the Bahamas in June is around 89F. There is relatively low chance of rain, but it can happen, so be ready. Water temperature will be around 85F during our stay.



CARRY-ON PACK

Luggage can take a while to reach your stateroom. Make sure to have a carry-on with your essentials to get you through at least dinner. Our recommendations are: All documents (you will need these to get on-board), medications (we advise that all medications remain in their original, labeled prescription containers), bathing suits, sunscreen, hats, sunglasses, and some bottled water.

DAY 1 – JUNE 15TH

BOARDING DAY

It is very important you get into the Cruise before 1:30.

LUGGAGE

You will drop your luggage with the Porter before boarding. They will tag your bag with your stateroom information. Make sure to print off your documents prior to arriving so you have all the information ready. You will receive an email to check-in online about 3-4 days prior to departure. This will speed up your on-boarding process.

ROOMS AT THE READY

The Crew will try and have all staterooms ready by 1:30 p.m. before departure. You can board as early as 11:00 a.m. and head to the Windjammer café for a meal (Located on Deck 9 at the front of the ship). This will be a buffet-style and a good opportunity to mingle with fellow passengers.

EMERGENCY DRILL (MUSTER STATION)

Promptly at 3:30 p.m. you will be required to gather at your 'muster station'. This number can be found on your Sail-Pass Card that will be provided when you get on-board. All 'muster' stations are located on Deck 6. Arrive a few minutes early as it gets crowded quickly. There is no cell phone use during this drill and the Crew will give you instructions.

UNICITY AMERICAS MEETING

Promptly after the Emergency Drill we will meet in the conference center located on Deck 6 behind the Schooner Bar. We will make sure to have signage out so you can find us. This meeting will start at 4:00 p.m. Here we will go over some of the details of the cruise as well as provide you with much needed Unicity swag! At this meeting you will receive \$100 USD per person for activities along with other great Rewards Trip items. You must attend!

DEPARTURE DAY DINNER

Our assigned dinner time for the 'My Fair Lady' dining hall is 6:00 p.m. This is located on Deck 4 at the center of the ship. We will dine together on the first night as a group. The seat assignment will be provided to you upon check in. These will be the assigned seats for the remainder of the cruise if you choose to eat breakfast or dinner in the restaurant.

Tip: There are a variety of shows and activities at all hours of the cruise. You will be provided a guide upon arrival so you can find the hours and locations and schedule accordingly. There are also 3 pools located on Deck 9 for your convenience as well as a full gym at the rear of the ship. Deck 10 is rarely crowded but it is full of sun and incredible views.

DAY 2 – JUNE 16TH

BEACH DAY, COCOCAY BAHAMAS

CocoCay is a private Bahama island owned by the Royal Caribbean. The snorkeling is top notch here and there are several lagoons to choose from. You can also find wave runners, an Aqua park and lots of chairs to lounge in. There are local artisans that have wares for sale so bring cash if you would like. You are required to keep your Sail-Pass card with you to get off the ship as well as get back on. There is a cool Barbeque on the island with plenty of music to keep you moving! You can select from a variety of activities.



DAY 3 – JUNE 17TH

NASSAU BAHAMAS

Nassau is famous for high-end shopping with no tax or duties. Be prepared to do some walking and exploring in the straw market. Make sure you have your Sailpass card and Passport in order to get back on the ship. You do have to clear US Customs to return.

If you aren't into shopping, we recommend a more cultural tour. The Queens Staircase is nearby and will take you to one of the remaining forts located in Nassau. There is a small fee to get inside the Fort so be prepared with cash. From the fort you have a great view of the island. There are several museums close by as well.



DAY 4 – JUNE 18TH

MIAMI, FLORIDA DEPARTURE DAY

While we are sad the trip is ending this day, we hope you have enjoyed your trip. If you have late flights, you can plan local excursions to the nearby everglades, Miami beaches and shopping areas close by. If you have earlier flights, you can disembark early if you are able to navigate stairs and carry all of your luggage with you. You will receive information about the process the night before in your stateroom.
